We believe there are some key factors that may have led to our low complication rate with ÉsterilSol™ and high owner satisfaction:

- Communication with clients and follow-up
- Sedation and pain control
- Permanent marking Well trained veterinarians
- Selection criteria of patients





Further clinical and field research needed with respect to EsterilSol™:

- Universal and permanent identification protocol
- Studies on peri and post-injection pain;
- Behavioural changes with emphasis on sexual and aggressive tendencies, human bite incidence and territoriality. \*\* Data is presently being evaluated on some of these points from household surveys in Todos Santos 2009-2010;
- Studies on testicular size and consistency changes post-injection
